Short stories and non-fiction pieces should not be longer than **6 pages** (1,5 spacing, Times New Roman 12) and poems should not be longer than **2 pages** altogether. Only one piece of writing per person. The winners will be chosen by members of staff (the two organizers + others) anonymously. There are no restrictions genre-wise, poems, your non-fiction pieces, and short stories could deal with everything from sci-fi to the ongoing pandemic. Please only put the title of your piece (not your name) on the **PDF** you are handing in and send to [dmoroney@uni-bonn.de](mailto:dmoroney@uni-bonn.de) by **midnight July 12**.

We'll celebrate the winners on **August 6, 4pm** and you will be asked before-hand whether you'd like to read your winning piece of creative writing yourself or if another person should do that for you. So please check your emails a few days before the event! The event will take place via Zoom and we will not be judging you if you are getting out your formal evening attire and some champagne for the occasion! ;-) We certainly will to celebrate your brilliance!
