Welcome to the second IAAK Queer Week!

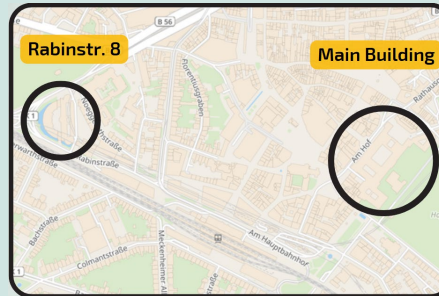

Please make sure to visit our **website** to find the **complete schedule and further information** on the individual events such as **content notes** as well as **changes to the program**, should they occur:

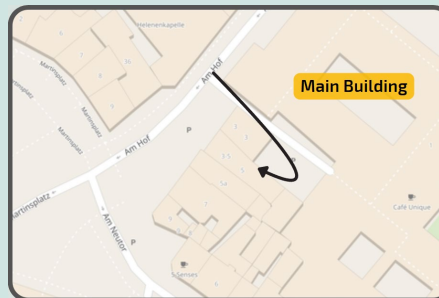


## How to find us
